



Repot a Plant

How to Repot Your Plant

- Choose a pot that is 1 to 2 inches wider than the original pot and that features drain holes. Different kinds of plants (e.g., cacti, herbs, bulbs, roses, etc.) have different needs, so be sure to select the right pot for your plant. If reusing a pot, first clean it with mild soap to kill potentially harmful organisms.
- Tip the plant over and gently ease it out of the pot. Slice the root ball in two places if roots are tightly wound.
- Fill one-third of the new pot with a fresh dose of premium potting mix, like Miracle-Gro® Potting Mix. Set the plant in the pot, and then add potting mix until the plant's previous soil level is matched in the new pot.
- Water thoroughly and don't forget to feed with plant food. Make sure to follow label instructions as to the appropriate time to feed the plant.
